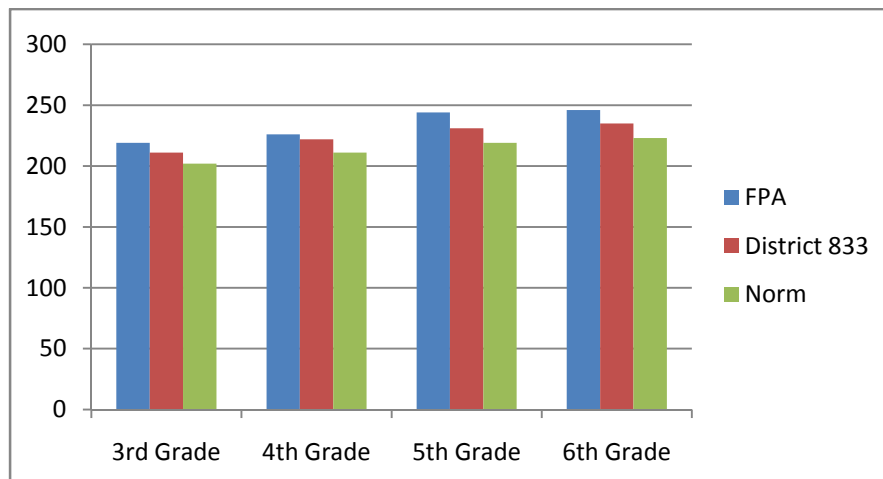


# NWEA Testing Results

#### Math RIT Scores



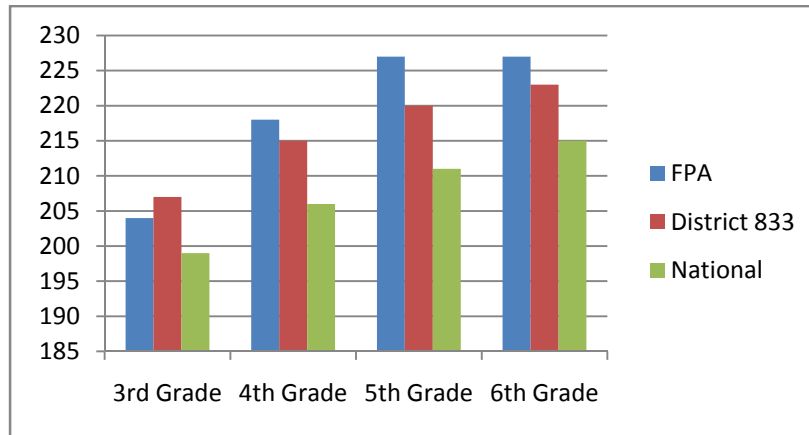

#### Math Test Score Summary

- In grades 2-6, FPA students are outscoring the local district and national norm.
- By 6<sup>th</sup> grade, FPA students are scoring an average of 20 RIT points higher.

**\*\*\*NWEA scores can be used as a predictor for how students will score on the MCA-II (Minnesota State Test) with a 90% accuracy rate.**

## Reading Test Score Summary

- In the first year of testing, FPA second graders outscored both the local district and the national norm by an average of 7 RIT points.
- In grades 4-6, FPA is outscoring both the local district and the national norm.
- According to a correlation study, NWEA scores can predict how a student will perform on the MCA-II. In grades 2-6, FPA student average RIT scores place our student score average at every grade in the “Exceeds Standards” level.
